Register To Vote

You must be registered to vote at least 29 days prior to Election Day in order to be eligible to vote in the election. You may register in person at the Elections Office or the voter application is available online. Any new registrations received after the deadline will be deferred until after the election.

The canvass of vote by mail ballots will begin at 9:00 a.m. on **November 5, 2018** and the canvass of returns and vote by mail ballots will continue at 4:00 p.m. on **November 6, 2018**.

Vote By Mail

If you will be away from home during the election or prefer to vote by mail, please call the Elections Office to request a vote by mail ballot. Vote By Mail ballot requests are valid for 2 General Election cycles; please call to verify request is current.

VOTE BY MAIL REQUEST DEADLINE:

General Election - October 31, 2018

Has your signature changed?

Handwriting changes over time. Signature updates can be made at any time, but must be received before Vote By Mail Ballots are canvassed in order to be accepted for an election. (F.S. 98.077) Voters may update their signature by completing and mailing a Voter Registration Application to the Supervisor of Elections.
